Now I would like te ask two question: 1. As you know Dr. Junius Bird sent a sample of C.14 from Barrea= les culture, of Argentina, Samile that I dug out some time ago. That sample (L. 507) has, and antiquity of 1:100 ± 150 years according with a letter of Dr. Bird, but the information was not published yet. Se may I use that result in a paper that I am goig to publish? 2. Would you be so kind in sending me reprints of the C.14 dates published for your laboratory, and also te put my name in the list of persons to whom the reprints are mailed?
