Dear Dr. Kulp:

I have read your excellent paper published in the last issue of American Antiquity. Congratulations, the archaeologist needed since long time ago that "mise au point" of the problem of the C.14 possibilities. As we are not specialist in nuclear physics, many articles were not understandable to us, I remember an article on the same subject that after many days of study I gave up, without reaching a conclusion on the credit we shall put on the C.14 possibilities.

Now I would like to ask two questions:

1. As you know Dr. Junius Bird sent a sample of C.14 from Barreales culture, of Argentina, sample that I dug out some time ago. That sample (L.307) has, an antiquity of $1:130 \pm 130$ years according with a letter of Dr. Bird, but the information was not published yet. Can I use that result in a paper that I am going to publish?
2. Would you be so kind in sending me reprints of the C.14 dates published for your laboratory, and also to put my name in the list of persons to whom the reprints are mailed?

As the Guggenheim Foundation has awarded me a fellowship to go to work one year in the States, I would be very interested in visiting you and your laboratory, I expect that visit could be accomplished next April or May:
